

## Explanation

In this exercise, you'll work on giving and receiving peer feedback on your assignment. You'll go through several steps, after which you can use the insights you gain to improve your assignment.

You submitted your assignment through a peer feedback application (e.g. FeedbackFruits). This application paired you with a fellow student to provide feedback.

Please complete the first steps in this form before providing peer feedback.

## In advance

After you've completed your assignment, but before you begin the exercise, it's a good idea to reflect on how the writing went. Answer the following questions below:

- To what extent are you satisfied with your assignment and why?
- What went well about the assignment?
- What did you find difficult and what challenges did you face?
- If you could have talked to an expert while writing, what feedback would you have sought? Try to make your request as specific as possible.

## The exercise

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Complete the following steps. Only proceed to the next step once you've completed the previous one.

Start by watching the video about peer feedback.

Then complete the questions below.

- What criteria do you think good peer feedback should meet?

Now go to the peer feedback application and provide feedback on the work of the student you are linked to.

After providing peer feedback, please complete the questions below.

### **Part 1: After you have given peer feedback, but before you have read the peer feedback from your fellow students**

- Take another look at your own work: which tips you gave your fellow student also apply to your own work? And are there any other tips you give yourself based on comparing it to your fellow student's work?

## The exercise (continued)

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- What strengths did you discover in your own assignment after giving peer feedback and comparing it with your fellow student's work?

- What concrete action points and/or areas for improvement have you noticed in your own work by providing peer feedback?

## The assignment (continued)

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### Part 2: After the peer feedback is released.

Now read the peer feedback you received from your fellow student. This feedback may evoke certain emotions or feelings. It's helpful to acknowledge these so you can let them go and focus on the content.

- What do you think of the form and content of the feedback you received? What emotions does the peer feedback evoke in you?

Try to let go of any emotions the feedback may have evoked. Sometimes this can be achieved by briefly stepping back from the feedback, doing something else, and then completing this section later. Decide for yourself if you need that time. Continue with this section when you can consider the content without too much emotion.

- Which strengths have been identified and what do you do with them?

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- What tips were given and which tips will you take with you?

- What did you learn more from, giving or receiving feedback?

## After the assignment

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- What concrete action points and/or improvements will you implement based on giving and receiving peer feedback?
