



How to apply for a scholarship

Welcome to this instruction page on how to apply for a scholarship. Applying for a scholarship requires you to take a few simple steps. Before starting your application, please make sure that you have all the necessary application documents at hand.

1. First, navigate to [Osiris](#).
2. Log in with your student account if you are not logged in yet.
3. Once you've logged into your OSIRIS account click on **Cases**.



4. Afterwards click on the *green +* button bellow.
5. Click on the option "Financial Support"
6. Afterwards click on the case named: "Application Scholarship Research Master Erasmus MC 2026"
7. Afterwards **select one** the Research Master Program that you've already apply for.
8. Select the scholarships that you would like to apply for:
