

Transition Regulation Master Economics and Business 2021

As of the academic year 2021-2022, the study load of the seminars in the specialisations *Behavioural Economics*, *Financial Economics*, *Strategy Economics*, *Marketing* and *Urban*, *Port and Transport Economics* has been reduced from 12 ec to 10 ec.

Senior students who, in a previous academic year, have completed both for their specialisation compulsory seminars at 12 ec, can graduate in the old study programme.

Senior students who, in a previous academic year, have completed one of the two in these specialisations compulsory seminars at 12 ec, only have the possibility to follow the other mandatory seminar in the academic year 2021-2022 and complete it at 12 ec by making an additional assignment of 2 ec. They can contact the relevant seminar coordinator for this.

For these students it is also possible to follow the other compulsory seminar in the academic year 2021-2022 and to finish it at 10 ec. In that case, they must take one extra Economics and Business master course (4 ec), with the exception of the core courses from the specialisation Data Science and Business Analytics, in order to fill in the remaining 2 ec.
