




## How to apply for an ESE Excellent Student Waiver

You can submit a request for a waiver (**for ESE BSc students only**) following the steps below

Step 1. Log-in on [Osiris](#)


Step 2: click on “Stay abroad requests” or click on the “globe-icon”




Step 3: click on the  on the bottom right-hand side

Step 4: select your bachelor programme

Step 5: click on “ESE Application Scholarship 2025”



Step 6: fill out the start and end date (1-09-2025 and 31-08-2025)
