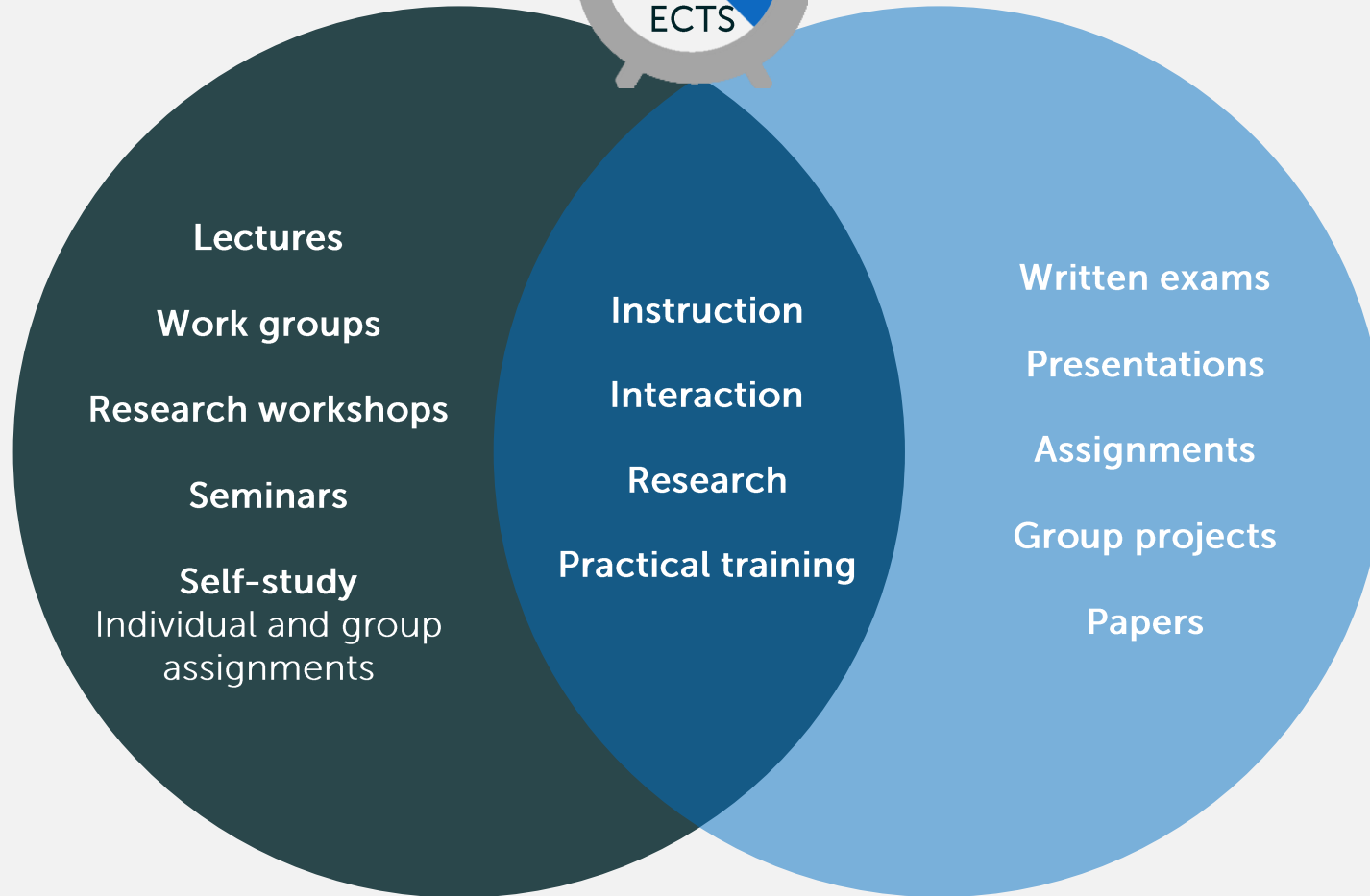
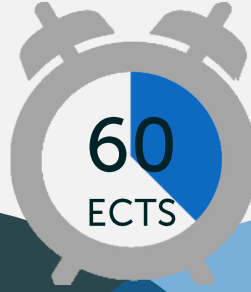

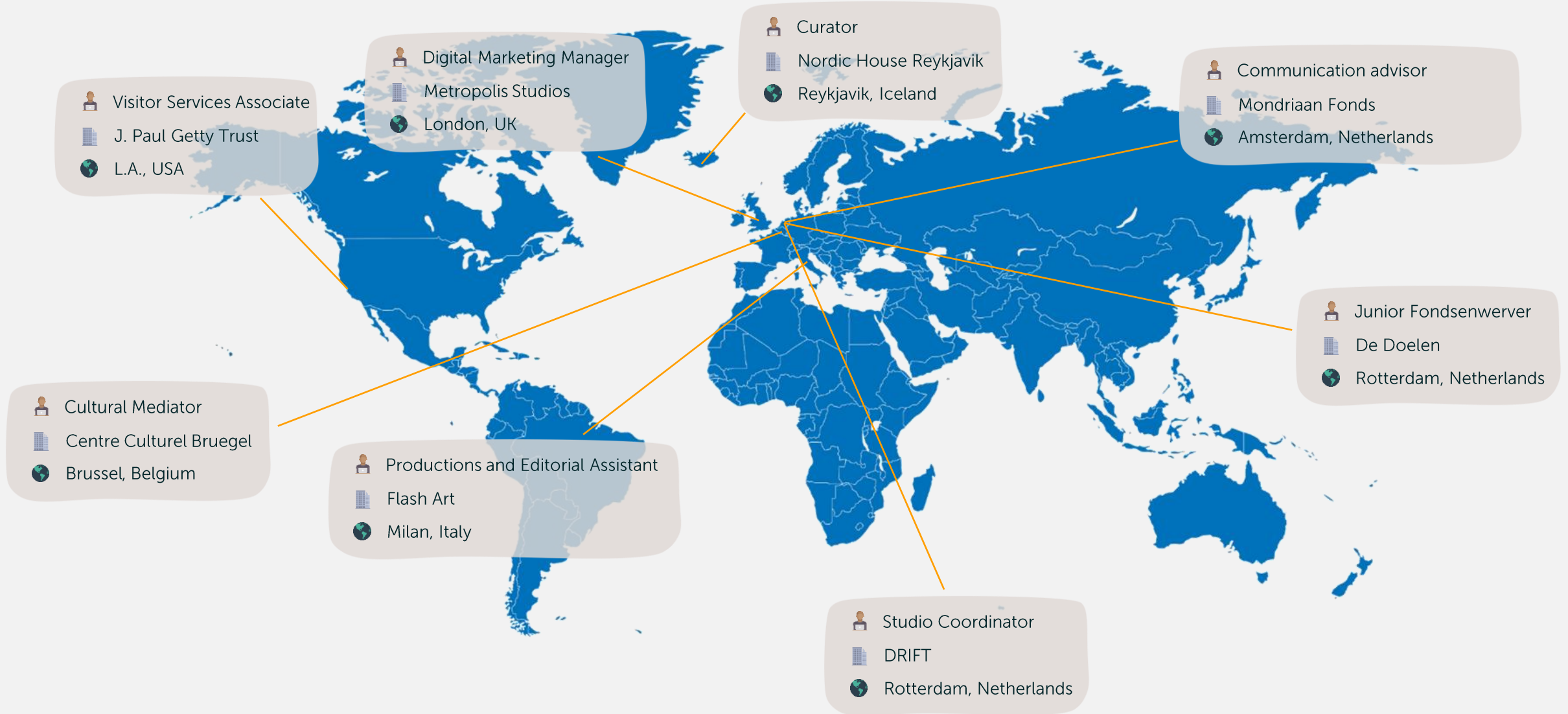

Application deadlines

1 April 2026 for non-EEA students
1 May 2026 for EEA students

Diploma requirements

A Dutch VWO diploma
A 'propedeuse' diploma from the first year of Dutch HBO programme
A secondary (high) school diploma equivalent to the Dutch VWO diploma.

English language requirements

TOEFL with a minimum score of 90
IELTS with a minimum score of 6.5 overall
Cambridge C1 Advanced or Cambridge C2 Proficiency with a minimum score of 180
LanguageCert with a minimum score of 70
Pearson PTE Academic with a minimum score of 70
