













Economic Injustice Widening Income & Wealth Gaps in the USA

Patriarchal Leadership

- Exacerbates inequities and racial/gender disparities
- Denies systemic problems to sustain status-quo

Antiracist, Feminist Leadership



- Based on collaboration, inclusivity & participation
- Distributes wealth & power
 - prioritizes investments in communities & workers rights
- Reduces inequities/disparities by centering racial justice
- Leverages transformation by linking problems
