Pre Academic Programme

Before the kick-off of the new academic year, Erasmus University Rotterdam (EUR) organises the Pre Academic Programme. During this course, you will learn everything you need to start your studies well-prepared. This course is <u>free of charge</u> for all starting bachelor students at EUR.

What can you expect of the Pre Academic Programme?

When?

The Pre Academic Programme is held from 31 July until 18 August 2023. The programme consists of 3 digital modules and 2 campus activities. Each module accounts for a couple hours of workload. This investment in yourself will absolutely be worth the effort. In fact, it will probably save you time during your study programme, since you'll also be developing effective study strategies. Your first weeks at uni can be daunting, so it's crucial to start well prepared. You can finish the modules at your own pace and finish the assignments individually.
