Welcome Step 2 of 6

If you wish to enroll in a Bachelor's programme at Erasmus University Rotterdam (EUR), including Erasmus MC programmes, and you do not have a diploma that provides immediate entry, you can be admitted by successfully completing an entrance examination: the Entrance Examination Colloquium Doctum (CD)/ Mathematics deficiency test or the Entrance examination non-Dutch diploma.

The CD consists of various tests, which can vary per study programme or per faculty. In general, the tests are of pre-university level. You will only be admitted to the study programme of your choice if you pass each test in the examination. Also, students entering study programmes via successful completion of the CD must be 21 years of age or older when they start the relevant study programme.

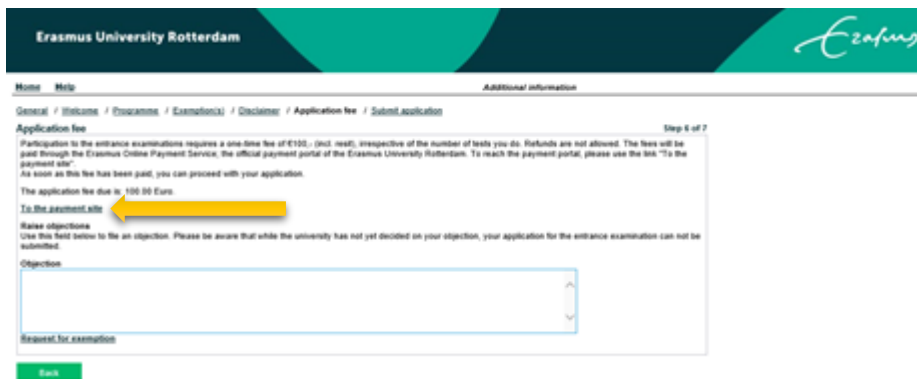
In this screen you choose the education for which you have already made an enrollment request in Studielink and for which you want to take the CD tests (e.g. Business Administration). Then click on Continue.

In this screen you choose the test you want to sign up for (Colloquium Doctum) and click on Continue.

This screen is not applicable, click Continue again

In this screen you declare that you have filled in everything truthfully. Select the option Yes, I declare and click on Continue.

This screen explains the cost of the test. If you want to pay immediately you can click on the link [To the payment](#) site. If you still want to change things you can click [Back](#) to go back to the previous page.



The last step in the registration process is the payment for the test. If you clicked on the link [To the payment](#) site in the previous screen, you will be taken to the screen below. You can now make the payment.

Please note that you must go through the process below at once otherwise you will get an error message and the registration has not been received by us.



After completing the payment, you will receive an email message to your student email account within 2 working days. (MYEUR or in Osiris student)
