

## TWO TO TWELVE QUIZ

### Instruction for participants

- During the class, this quiz is played simultaneously in teams. Online, this means that each team has its own breakout room with a game leader.
- The aim of the quiz is to guess a word of 12 letters. For each answer given, the team receives a letter.
- Before the team starts, decide which team members will answer the questions and who will look things up (50-50 distribution). The players try to answer questions about the subject matter from memory. This generates bonus points. If the players are not sure or do not know an answer, the other members start looking up the answers. While they do this, the game continues with the other players from the team.
- The game leader asks twelve questions. In total, there are 20 minutes to ask and answer questions. The team decides how long they take over a question. The team is responsible for optimally using those 20 minutes.
- After each answer, the team is given a letter. The right letter for a correct answer, a wrong letter for an incorrect answer. However, you only hear afterwards which answer is right and which is wrong.
- The team notes the answers and the letters received on the scoresheet (see p2). Received letters are also copied in the top horizontal row of letters.
- After the twelve questions have been asked, there are twelve letters in the top row of letters. They are not in the right order. The team has five minutes to make a word with them. The team can 'buy' letters. The game leader then says where the letter in the bottom row should be placed. This costs the team 5 points per letter. If the team buys a letter whose answer was wrong, a question mark is placed in the bottom row.
- After around 20 minutes, the answers are discussed in a plenary session (by the lecturer or supervised by the lecturer). During this time, the game leaders count the score of each team.
- The winner is announced.

### Counting points

- Each correct answer +10
- Each answer from memory +10 bonus
- The word guessed +300
- Every bought letter -5
