

Invitation: roundtable discussion Code of Conduct for Research Integrity

Dear colleague,

In the autumn of 2021, the Association of Universities (VSNU) will organize a number of digital roundtable discussions about the experiences with the Netherlands Code of Conduct for Research Integrity ([link](#)), for the purpose of the interim evaluation of the implementation of the Code. The aim of these roundtable discussions is to collect experiences and possible bottlenecks in practice in the implementation and application of the Code. Where applicable, good practices regarding the implementation and publicity of the Code will be shared.

The Code of Conduct includes 21 duties of care for institutions, divided into five categories: training and supervision, research culture, data management, publication and dissemination, and ethical norms and procedures. These duties of care and the standards for good research practices form the basis for the roundtable discussions. Based on topical discussion questions, participants will be invited to share experiences and challenges with each other and to come up with (new) ideas for further development.
