General Admission Requirements Erasmus University Rotterdam 2023/2024

The Central Admissions Office has compiled a list of the most common international diplomas that meet the minimum admission requirements.

Please note:

- You are not automatically granted admission to a Bachelor's degree programme if your diploma is on the list.
- You are welcome to contact the Admissions Office in case your diploma is not listed and you are interested in studying at Erasmus University Rotterdam.

In general, we require students to have taken final exams in general education subjects as we do not accept applied subjects. For some diplomas, we have determined which subjects we accept. Please see below.

International Diplomas

International Baccalaureate

When applying ensure that the levels of all subjects, including the language-related ones, are clearly indicated (HL, SL, A or B, etc.).

European Baccalaureate

For medicine, all examinations in the natural sciences subjects must be taken in writing.

British (International) A-levels

A minimum of 3 approved (international) A-levels in general academic subjects* with final grades between A*- C plus 3 (I)GCSEs in 6 different subjects.

*Generally accepted subjects: All languages**, Ancient History, Biology, Chemistry, Classical Civilisation, Classical Studies, Computer Science, Economics, Environmental Science / Technology, Further Mathematics, Geography, Government and Politics, History, History of Art, Islamic Studies, Law, Life and Health Sciences, Marine Sciences, Mathematics, Philosophy, Physics, Politics, Psychology, Religious Studies, Sociology, Statistics.

Languages other than English that are your **native language are not preferred and will only be accepted as a 4^{th} A-level.

NB Only one of your 3 GCE A-Level subjects may be a language, e.g. English Language and Greek are not counted as 2 individual A-Levels.

Certain A-Level subjects with an applied component are only accepted for certain Bachelor degree programmes. For example, Media Studies is accepted for International Bachelor Communication and Media but not for the Bachelor in Management of International Social Challenges. Likewise, the A-Level Physical Education is accepted for International Bachelor in Psychology but not for International Bachelor History.

Overlapping subjects: Narrow subject combinations such as Economics, Business and Accounting or Physical Education, Biology and Psychology are not preferred.



American High School Diploma (outside USA)

From an accredited high school; a minimum GPA of 3.00 plus 4 independent AP courses in general academic subjects (with grade 3 or higher). AP exams* are required to be taken externally with College Board.

* Accepted subjects: Art History, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Comparative Government and Politics, European History, Human Geography, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Psychology, United States Government and Politics, United States History, World History: Modern, Calculus AB or BC, Computer Science Principles, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics, World Languages and Cultures.

Languages other than English that are your **native language are not preferred and will only be accepted as a 5thAP.

Overlapping subjects are counted as 1 AP exam. For example, AP US History, AP European History and AP World History are not counted as 3 individual AP's but as one. The same applies to AP Macro-Economics and AP Micro-Economics.

Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination (CAPE)

Proof of at least five independent general education subjects* with grades "Grade I" to "Grade III", including English and Mathematics. Among these examination subjects, there must be at least two "Unit 2" subjects.

*Accepted subjects: Applied Mathematics, Biology, Caribbean Studies, Chemistry, Economics, Environmental Science, French, Geography, History, Integrated Mathematics, Literatures in English, Physics, Pure Mathematics, Sociology, Spanish
