Boost research visibility to deepen public insight and to increase trust and engagement

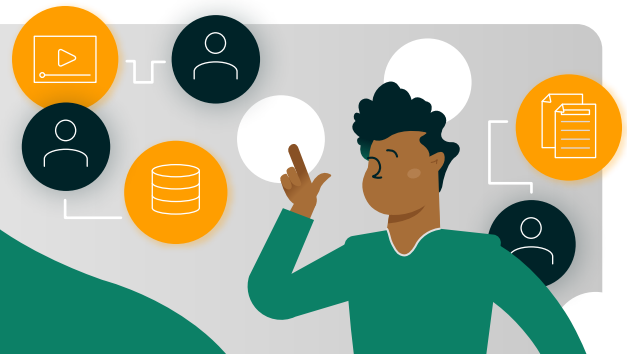


Ethical and democratic
