# **Secure housing**

A significant aspect of your preparations for studying abroad involves securing safe and affordable accommodation. In the Netherlands, student housing is not provided by the university. You are responsible for arranging your own accommodation. A limited number of rooms is reserved for about 25% of incoming international students, however, most of you will need to find housing on the private market. # **Immigration procedures**

Most international students from outside the EU/EEA studying in the Netherlands for more than three months, need to apply for an entry visa and/or a Dutch residence permit. After acceptance, you will be informed on all immigration procedures by our Team Immigration.

#### **Insurance**

When living in the Netherlands, you are legally required to have sufficient health insurance. We strongly recommend arranging health, liability and travel insurance before your trip to the Netherlands. It is your responsibility to arrange insurance, ideally two weeks before your departure. This way, you are also covered during your journey and right after arrival. There are several insurance providers that offer health insurance for international students.

## **Public transport**

Erasmus University collaborates with Student Mobility to provide international students easy access to all forms of transport in the Netherlands. With Student Mobility you are able to receive a customized public transport card (+ an ISIC Student-ID) with special discounts for international students! You can use this card for train, tram, metro and bus.

# First registration in NL

If you're moving to the Netherlands, you are usually required to register with the municipality where you'll be living. This process is known as "first registration". Depending on the length of your stay, different rules may apply.

#### **Dutch bank account**

Opening a Dutch bank account might come in handy, sometimes your account from your home country won't suffice.

**When & how to open a bank account** 

#### **General Practitioner**

During your time as student in the Netherlands, you may find yourself in the situation where you need medical care or professional support. Since your General Practitioner (GP) will be your first point of call in case of any health issue you may encounter, we strongly recommend you to register with a GP as soon as possible after your arrival in the Netherlands. We suggest Jans Huisartsen, they have a lot of experience with, and facilities for, international students.

#### Sim card

If you are staying in the Netherlands for a short period, your most feasible option would be to get a prepaid SIM card. You can pick up a free Lebara SIM card at the ESN office on campus Woudestein. Another option is to get an e-sim.
