

Bank transfer procedure

The amount that you need to transfer is the applicable tuition fee, immigration fee and living fee (€ 900 x the number of months you will be studying in the Netherlands). The living fee should correspond with the duration of your programme (with a maximum of 12 months - €10.800 – if you enroll for a programme of more than one year). The living fee is fully refundable.

Important: The living fee deposit excludes the non-refundable tuition fees and immigration fee of € 321. We prefer to receive the three amounts for the tuition fees, living fee and immigration fee as total at once instead of separate payments.

IMPORTANT: Please note that all additional fees that the banks may charge for the international bank transfer must be covered by yourself!

Refund procedure

Once you have arrived in the Netherlands and opened a Dutch bank account, you can submit your refund request for the transferred living fees. We will inform you on this in August.

Important: ensure that you are financially covered during the first few weeks in the Netherlands, as the refund procedure may take a couple of weeks.
