

Scholarship letter

If you are going to receive a scholarship for your study at Erasmus University Rotterdam, you can prove that you have sufficient financial means by submitting a copy of the official scholarship letter from the scholarship provider.

The scholarship letter must contain the following details:

- ✓ Your name, initials and date of birth
- ✓ The issuing date of the award letter
- ✓ The name and address of the scholarship provider or the institute providing the grant
- ✓ The name of the scholarship programme
- ✓ The period covered by the scholarship (from start date to end date), which must cover the entire duration of your study period at Erasmus University Rotterdam
- ✓ A breakdown of the scholarship budget, clearly indicating that an amount of at least €900 per *month of study* is made available to you for living expenses in the Netherlands and the applicable amount of tuition fees.
 - **Important:** if it is less than € 900 per month + the applicable amount for tuition fees, you will need to transfer the additional funds to our bank account (see the procedure 'bank transfer', which you can find in the form).

If you are unsure if the scholarship award letter includes all required details, we strongly advise you to ask your scholarship provider to complete a scholarship certificate as additional proof (see format on the next page).
