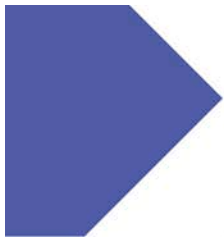


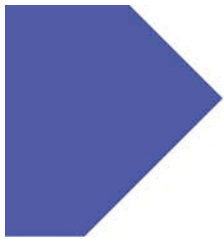

Exchange and Study Abroad Students are the <u>only</u> group of UTS students who can take advantage of our special Housing Guarantee*.</p> <p>Application Deadlines</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Session 2 2016 – Opens TBC - Apply before - 15th June 2016 • Session 1, 2017 – Opens TBC - Apply before – 30th November 2016 <p>*Note that UTS Housing cannot guarantee a particular type/style/expense of accommodation, but booking earlier provides higher chances of securing a preferred housing type.</p> |
| <p>Housing Applications</p> | <p>www.housing.uts.edu.au</p> <p>Students should enter their UTS Student Number and select ‘Exchange’ or ‘Study Abroad’ Student Type – this is the same as their UTS Application Number.</p> <p>Housing Fees: A non-refundable application fee of \$40 applies.
