Minimum requirement for incoming students:	 They should present a Learning Agreement with 30 ECTS credits per semester in order to be accepted as Erasmus students. European Card of Health Insurance must be shown upon registration.
Linguistic requirements:	Evidence of English Language Competence equal (or higher) to Level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, as attested by the relevant certificates. Evidence of English Language Competence can also be provided with an official certificate issued by the home institution.
Minimum requirement for outgoing students:	All outgoing students should take a study program of 30 ECTS credits per semester. They must submit with their application an official proof of knowledge of the language taught at the host institution.
